There is a maximum of **five** places available at each workshop.

Workshop times are usually: **10:00am - 4:30pm** (including a 30 minute lunch break).

All day tea & coffee is provided. It is recommended that you bring your own lunch. There is a refrigerator and microwave for use at the studio and there are take-away shops and an IGA a short drive away.

Workshops must be **paid in full 7 days** prior to the workshop date(s).

If for some reason a workshop does not go ahead (e.g. not enough registered participants) - **your fee will be refunded in full.**

A full refund will be offered to you if you need to cancel your attendance **7 days** prior to the workshop(s) date. Less than seven days notice will incur a **50%** cancellation fee. In most cases full fees can be transferred to another workshop at a later date if spaces are available.

The price of each workshop varies depending on the amount of materials required in the workshop kit. (e.g. lamp shade making kit - value \$30.00, length of pagent silk material for Nuno workshop - \$30.00, wool roving at \$10.00 per 100grams, etc.)

Each workshop includes a workshop kit, which provides all materials (e.g. wool roving, embellishments, silk material, silk scarf, lampshade making kit, fabric dyes, notions, etc.,) you will need for that particular workshop. Participants also have access to any other equipment necessary during the workshop time.

Participants will be given an simple list of equipment to bring. This will be basic felting equipment to enable participants to continue their felting journey post workshop. However, any equipment required will also be available at the studio for use during the workshop regardless.
