

Nuno Felting & Silk Dyeing

The combination of light weight silk material and wool roving felted together creates 'Nuno' felt. This is beautiful light weight material can be used for garments, scarfs, wraps and in soft furnishings. There are a multitude of ways to create Nuno felt from creating very light 'cobweb' material to high textured pieces that include 'waves', 'roses' and 'rivers' of texture made by manipulating the silk and wool. In this workshop we will dye our silk using the 'microwave method' and then we will create an infinity shrug or wrap as well as have fun playing with other Nuno felting methods.

Although this workshop includes advanced techniques, it is still suitable for anyone with very little experience in felting.

Participants Equipment List

- Clean empty ice cream containers or plastic bowl / small bucket.
- Bubble wrap (Approx. 70cm x 50 cm)
- 1/2 a 'pool noodle' or 1/2 a broom stick or similar (acting as a big rolling pin)
- 2 old towels to soak up excess water.
- Dressmaker tape measure (optional)
- Some 'wool friendly' soap e.g. lux flakes, olive oil/goat's milk soap.
- Empty shampoo/dishwashing liquid bottle or clean 1 litre plastic milk bottle with small holes punched into cap (or water pear/* Brause ball) for wetting down wool
- Sewing needle and strong synthetic thread
- A pair of small, sharp needle nose scissors (embroidery scissors are great)
- Plastic bags to take damp work and towels home
- *Optional - dishwashing/latex gloves - if hands are sensitive to soap.*
- *Optional - small lengths on interesting wool/yarns, silk hankies/fibre, scraps of open weave materials such as muslin, silk, hessian (avoid synthetic materials)*
- Pen and notebook (some printed note are provided)

*** Other items/materials provided by tutor: (\$30.00 *materials fee included in workshop cost)**

- 1.5 metre of pajent silk material (enough to make an 'eternity shrug' and a scarf and several samples)
- Use of silk dyes, disposable gloves, paper towels, cling wrap, various pouring tools.
- Glug (soap solution) & Vinegar
- Some printed notes
- Some embellishment items, interesting yarns, scraps of silk, etc.

- *Tutor will also have Brause Balls (watering pears) available for sale @ \$25.00 each.*
- *Tutor will have Pagent silk and other silks available for purchase from \$10.00 per metre*
