

Introduction to Felting - Rae Woolnough

In this felting workshop participants will be introduced to the fascinating world of felt making. You will learn to make flowers, felted balls /beads, felted "Geodes" and decorative flat felt.

These items are small, but, collectively can make wonderful 'big' things. Think room-dividers, floral garlands, floor mats, soft furnishings, festive decorations, as well as use in obvious applications such as jewellery and hat embellishments.

This workshop is a wonderful introduction to felt making with techniques that include using resists, creating 3D objects, joining, blending colours, embellishing and creating ropes and cords.

Participant Material List

- Approx 100 - 200 gms of wool roving/tops in various colours (**available from the tutor at \$10.00 per 100 gms**)
- Length of bubble wrap approx. 70cm x 50cm
- Empty ice-cream or yogurt container or small bucket or bowl (water container)
- 2 x old towels (to soak up any excess water)
- Empty dishwashing liquid / shampoo bottle or empty, clean plastic 1 litre milk bottle with small holes punched into the lid (for wetting down the wool roving)
- Wool friendly soap, e.g. olive oil soap, baby soap, simple soap (avoid liquid soaps)
- Small lengths of interesting wool / yarns
- Small pair of scissors (embroidery scissors are great)
- Pen and note pad (some printed notes are provided)

Parking is available onsite.

Please bring your own lunch. There is a kitchen onsite with a microwave.

Shops and Cafe are a short drive away.

Tutor will provide, printed notes, wire, pipe cleaners, resist materials, soap solutions, embellishment materials, extra wool roving, etc.
